As regards the company's future environmental objectives, Dalton & Co. (Printers) Ltd. Shall:

- Meet all relevant environmental legislation, regulations and requirements to which the company subscribes.
- Ensure where possible that the pulp used for paper products is: derived from sustained forestry management and is elemental chlorine free.
- Encourage the use of recycled materials wherever possible.
- Minimise the creation of waste, wherever possible, establish a use for that waste; and where waste must be disposed of that it fully complies with all relevant legislation.
- Ensure that all employees are aware of this policy.
- Promote this policy to all suppliers and contractors.
- Give consideration the environmental impacts of its operations, with the overall objective being to improve its performance, e.g. power, water usage, transportation etc.
- Use Vegetable Oil (Soya) based printing inks and sealers.
